

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE GUNVAC HANDHELD VACUUM



GunVac - Handheld Vacuum - Deluxe Kit
Part Number: 1510



STEP 1
Connect Air Hose - Fit the compressed air hose into the vacuum gun's inlet securely.



STEP 2
Attach Tool - Attach the required tool based on the surface and material. For GunVac 1510, use (brush, crevice tool, etc.). For GunVac 1500, attach crevice tool to the nozzle.



STEP 3
Install Filter Bag - Fix the filter bag on the back side of the vacuum gun and close the zipper.



STEP 4
Open Air Valve - Slowly open the compressed air valve to allow air flow.

STEP 5
Start Vacuuming - Use the vacuum gun to collect dust, powder, debris or metal chips.



STEP 6
Turn off the air valve



STEP 7
Empty Filter Bag - Open the filter bag zipper and remove the collected material.



OPTIONAL
Use of Contain-It Kit for Larger Storage - For applications requiring higher debris collection capacity, use the Contain-It Kit, GunVac (1522) equipped with a standard cartridge filter which provides 5 gallons of storage for collecting vacuumed debris.

Maintenance and Storage:

- After use, clean the attachments and vacuum gun exterior.
- Store the vacuum gun and accessories in a clean, dry area.
- Periodically inspect the filter bag and replace it if damaged or worn out.
